



Registration is now open for the Avonworth Athletic Association’s 2019 Spring Youth Baseball season for children living within the Avonworth School District.

All registrations must be completed online at <http://www.avonworthbaseball.com> and **open enrollment ends on Monday, February 11th.**

Our **Spring In-House** program is available for children ages 4 through 17 with a range of instructional and competitive levels. Games are played Monday thru Saturday against other Avonworth and Quaker Valley In-House teams in the months April thru June.

In-House divisions and associated costs are as follows...

** There are two Tee-Ball divisions - one for 4-5 year olds and a separate division for 6 year olds.

PAYMENT – Only credit cards (Visa & Mastercard) will be accepted for payment through the AAA website. Payment by check is no longer an option. A payment plan option that allows for registration fees to be paid in two installments is available when enrolling.

FAMILY DISCOUNT – For those families registering multiple children, we are pleased to offer the following discount structure - which applies to In-House registrations ONLY. Families registering :

- **2 children** are eligible to receive a **\$10** discount off of their total registration amount.
- **3 children** are eligible to receive a **\$50** discount off of their total registration amount.
- **4 children** or more are eligible to receive a **\$100** discount off of their total registration amount.

VOLUNTEERING – The success of our program relies on a devoted group of adult volunteers in our community to help ensure that the organization remains a successful operation.

- **Concession Stand Volunteers:** The concession stand is an important source of revenue for the baseball association which is used to help fund the maintenance of fields and equipment purchases. **PLEASE NOTE:** Each AAA family participating in Tee Ball through Little League is required to volunteer at the concession stand at least once per season. Families can opt out of this requirement by paying a **\$75** fee during the registration process.
- **Prospective Managers and Coaches:** Please complete the Baseball Volunteer Application through the registration process on the website as well as **required background checks** if not already on file with the AAA within the past 5 yrs.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Prospective coaches should confirm if renewal is required this year and submit updated background checks. Information on obtaining and submitting background checks can be found on the AAA website under the [Coaches & Volunteers](#) section.

USA BASEBALL BAT REGULATION UPDATE – As of 2019, only USA Baseball approved bats will be allowed for use in the Tee Ball, Instructional League, Minor League, and Little League divisions. Bats manufactured prior to 2018 that were previously approved for Little League play are no longer allowed.
