

**Avonworth School District
Regular Meeting – September 13, 2021**

BOARD NOTES

The following items were approved at this meeting:

- Ratify payment of General Fund bills for August, 2021, beginning with Check #51870 and ending with Check #52036 in the amount of \$590,670.05.
- Ratify the August, 2021 payroll in the amount of \$1,114,616.22.
- Treasurer's Report for July 2021.
- Capital Project Fund payments in the amount of \$104,047.78.
- The budget transfers for August, 2021.
- The Title II Non-Public Agreement with the Allegheny Intermediate Unit for non-public services during the 2021-2022 School Year at a cost of \$2,037.96. (To be paid using allocated Title II funds.)
- To rescind the motion of June 14, 2021 approving the Agreement with Pediatric Therapy Specialists, Inc. and approve the new Agreement with Pediatric Therapy Specialists, Inc. to provide occupational and physical therapy services for the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 School Years. A lower rate has been negotiated.
- To renew the contractual agreement with Southwood Psychiatric Hospital to provide care for children and adolescents who are struggling with a number of mental health concerns. This agreement is for a daily rate for inpatient care services (\$90.00 per day of service). These services would be initiated when a student is in crisis and is required to be hospitalized in order to achieve emotional stabilization and a higher level of functioning.
- The District's participation in the Western Pennsylvania Learning 2025 Alliance at a cost not to exceed \$5,000 for the 2021-2022 School Year. The District will pay the \$10,000 registration fee and be provided a \$5,000 subsidy paid to the District by the Grable Foundation.
- A change in assignment for **Ms. Jill Stanton**, General Food Service Worker from 3.75 hours/day at the Primary Center to 4 hours/day at the Middle/High School retroactive to August 24, 2021 through August 31, 2021.
- A change of assignment for **Ms. Jill Stanton**, General Food Service Worker from 4 hours/day at the Middle/High School to a Substitute Food Service Worker effective September 1, 2021.
- The Assistant Superintendent job description.
- The renewal of the Cyber Services Agreement with the Seneca Valley School District through the 2024-2025 School Year.
- To declare 60 middle school football jerseys as obsolete and to donate them to the Football Boosters.
- To approve Change Order #02 for Allegheny City Electric, Inc., in the amount of \$8,025.91.
- Approval of the extension of the UGI Energy Services Agreement for natural gas supply and transportation for the period of September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2025 as negotiated on the District's behalf by the Western Pennsylvania Natural Gas Consortium.
- To declare old Middle and High School math textbooks as obsolete and to sell/donate/dispose of them accordingly.
- To approve IKM to begin the design phase of the Middle/High School Renovation project. (*Construction updates are available on the District website.*)
- To approve the Avonworth School District piloting a JV Golf Team for the remainder of the 2021-2022 season with a prorated stipend of \$1,000 to the current Golf Coach, **Mr. Todd Goble**.
- To accept the resignation of the following staff members from the supplemental positions shown:
 - A. **Ms. Melissa Costantino** from Grade 6 Lunch Duty.
 - B. **Ms. Tara Wahl** from High School Lunch Duty.
 - C. **Mr. Dave Como** as sponsor of the Gender & Sexual Alliance Club and as co-sponsor of the Derebus Yearbook.
- To change the status of **Ms. Shelby James** from Co-sponsor to Sponsor of the Derebus Yearbook for the 2021-2022 School Year.
