BOARD NOTES

The following items were approved at this meeting:

- The Minutes of the February 7, 2022 Work Session/General Purpose Meeting and the February 14, 2022 Regular Meeting.
- Ratify payment of General Fund bills for February 2022, beginning with Check #52984 and ending with Check #53159 in the amount of \$2,745,655.81.
- Ratify the February 2022, payroll in the amount of \$1,322,856.79.
- Treasurer's Report for January 2022
- Ratify payment of Food Service Fund bills for February, 2022, beginning with Check #3180 and ending with Check #3184 in the amount of \$27,703.09.
- Ratify payment of the Athletic Fund checks for February, 2022, beginning with Check #9561 and ending with Check #9581 in the amount of \$2,570.00.

 3. \$10,000 from Project Lead the Way Engineering for a Project Lead the Way corporate grant; approval for Mr. Bill White to receive stipends in the amount of \$85 for monitoring the grant, and \$50 for receipt of the grant. (\$85 was awarded in November 2021 for Mr. White writing the grant.)
- The proposed 2022-2023 AIU Program of Services Budget in the amount of \$2,243,173.00. The Allegheny County (AIU3) school districts' total contribution to the budget is \$1,809,390.00. The Avonworth School District's contribution to the Program of Services Budget is estimated to be \$34,289.00 and will be determined by PDE according to District Aid Ratio and Weighted Average Daily Membership (WADM).
