Avonworth High School educates 495 students in grades 9-12 from the boroughs of Ben Avon, Ben Avon Heights, and Emsworth along with Kilbuck and Ohio Townships. Students earned 5 on 27 tests, 4 on 47 tests and 3 on 51.

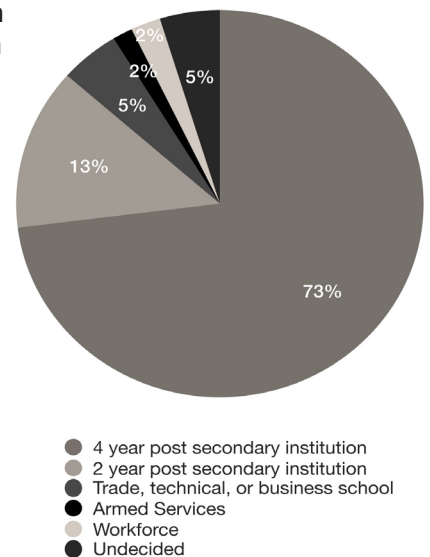
