Work Session/General Purpose Meeting – November 23, 2020

BOARD NOTES

The following items were approved at this meeting:

- The agreement with Consortium for Public Education which will be paid for with the Teacher in the Workplace grant awarded to the District in 2019-2020.
- A model for resuming Winter Sports and Activities beginning November 30th.
 - Resumption of Sports is dependent on completion of a facilities plan by the Athletic Director.
 - Resumption of Activities require that the Activity Sponsor submits a facility plan for their activity and receives approval from the respective building principal.
 - All plans shall require all participants to wear an approved mask at all times
 - Sports teams will participate only in dual meets or head to head matches (no multi-team tournaments)
 - In all cases the plan must include communication to our facility staff to arrange proper clean up after the activity
- A framework for decisions to change between Instructional Model Levels.
 - Decisions will be based on the PDE Instructional model chart including the County requirement for two weeks in a level to initiate a change in model.
 - The decision will be based on local and county positivity and incident rate data, deferring to the most concerning level of transmission, as well as specific District issues or concerns.
 - The District will communicate the plan for Instructional Model on a weekly basis.
- To approve Option 1 of the Attestation Ensuring Implementation of Mitigation Efforts from the Dept. of Health and the Dept. of Education as follows: All or some of the students within the public school entity are currently receiving in-person instruction and:
 1. We have read the Updated Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health Requiring Universal Face Coverings, effective November 18, 2020, including necessary exceptions and associated guidance, and affirm the public school entity is complying and will continue to comply with and enforce the Updated Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health Requiring Universal Face Coverings, including necessary exceptions and associated guidance.
